Direct Support Professional Award

NOMINATION GUIDELINES



The Direct Support Professional (DSP) Award is an opportunity to acknowledge hard work of human service workers who consistently demonstrate excellence, creativity, and commitment in providing supports to individuals with developmental disabilities and/or brain injuries. Four awards will be named.

Eligibility (of Nominee)

- 1. Must be employed by an ADDP member organization for at least six months
- 2. Must meet at least three qualities under criteria section

Criteria

Candidates will be evaluated based on how they demonstrate qualities in <u>at least three (3)</u> of the following areas:

- 1. <u>Advocacy</u>: Encourage activities to affect positive change on behalf of people with disabilities.
- 2. <u>Creativity</u>: Uses original ideas to provide individualized supports and services while respecting individual preference and encouraging self-determination and choice.
- 3. <u>Exceptional delivery of direct support</u>: Respects dignity, independence, culture, and rights of individuals with disabilities. Develops effective relationships with consumers.
- 4. <u>Dedication to best practice</u>: Seeks out opportunities to learn new skills and/or implements promising practices. Values community inclusion.
- 5. <u>Mentor</u>: Serves as role model for other staff.

Suggested Information

When completing nomination form include specific examples <u>showing how</u> candidate qualifies for award. Use strong examples. A weak versus strong example – **Weak:** "She always celebrates diversity." <u>STRONG</u>: "She is responsible for organizing the school's first multicultural training, an annual Cinco de Mayo celebration and organized assemblies featuring speakers of different cultural backgrounds."

Nomination Process

- 1. Submit a "Direct Support Professional Award Nomination Form" by February 16, 2018
- Write support letter (approx. 150 words or less) <u>OR</u> record a two (2) minute video (smart phone is okay) describing why nominee should get this award. This should be done by someone <u>other than</u> the nominator and submitted by February 16, 2018.
- 3. Incomplete submissions will not be considered.

Selection Process

- 1. The ADDP Conference Committee will select one winner per DDS region.
- 2. Nominators will learn results via email by late February 2018 and will be responsible to notify candidate of results.
- 3. Nominator will need to submit a high-quality electronic photo of winner by 2/27/18 for the event program book.
- 4. Honoree will be invited to attend the conference free of charge to receive award.
