Did you Know?

ADDP' recently released its Workforce Metrics Survey Report for October 2024.

Some key highlights:

- In general, vacancy rates across ADDP service providers showed a significant decrease from 2023, with the overall rate decreasing from 24% to 19%. Despite this progress, vacancy rates remain high in comparison to the overall Massachusetts job opening rate of less than 5%.
- Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) and Clinician Positions continue to be hardest to fill with vacancy rates for these positions having increased since our last survey.
- Day Program wait lists results were mixed with the combined waitlists for individuals receiving services prior to the pandemic decreasing from 1,215 to 731 in October 2024 but new referrals increasing from 1,502 to 1,682 for the same period.
